Each year, the Dressage at Devon Breed Show hosts hundreds of well-bred colts and fillies. Each is the product of careful breeding and watchful tending as they, hopefully, grow into champions. And each year, Dressage at Devon chooses one to follow on their path to Dressage at Devon. This year, we will follow Damascus, a striking colt, with a big blaze and lots of chrome.

Damascus was bred and is owned by one of the world's top riders, Catherine Haddad Staller. Catherine was actually first known in Germany for her success in breeding horses - long before she was recognized as a competitive rider. But, while her fame and success grew as a rider, Catherine remained focused on breeding the best. A few years ago, Haddad Staller brought a filly, Raureif (Elfentanz x Ramiros Bube) that Haddad-Staller also bred, to the United States as a yearling. Now four years old, she is the new mother of
