Volunteer Job Description

Dressage Explorers Crew

Overview: Children's Day is Sunday, Oct 1 only. We look for friendly, outgoing volunteers to help with a variety of fun, simple crafts and activities geared for the young at heart. This is a great way to try out volunteering and influence our next generation of dressage stars.

What Will I Do?

Several assignment areas available, some require knowledge of show grounds.

- **Make & Take Stick Horse** - Children pick out the elements for their own pool noodle pony and volunteers put them together. Volunteers help set up assembly line and then "flip" the tent while kids are parading in the Dixon Oval so they return to a Princess Party of lemonade and cookies.
- **"Pick" a Prize** - What could be more basic than learning to handle a manure pick?! We fill an inflatable pool with shavings and litter it with brown painted eggs with a prize (and also Minnie snicker bars and such - get it?!). Kids use a manure fork to pick their prize - volunteers ensure one child at a time, one prize per child and keeps the shavings littered.
- **Floaters** - Help where needed between activities and wrangling kids to get to the Dixon Oval for the Parade Down Center Line. We need some folks who can be flexible and help where needed.
- **Greeters** - We have over a dozen community organizations (4-H, Pony Club, DVCTA, etc.) setting up tables for the day - including some unicorns arriving. We need 2 experienced volunteers from 8am-10am to help greet folks at the back gate and direct them to a greeter in the picnic grove area. Volunteers need to be familiar with the show grounds and be able to help ensure drop off/parking/set up are timely.

Requirements

- Min age: 18
- Friendly and approachable demeanor.
- Dress appropriately for working with children.

Training:

- Mostly done in advance. The Dressage Explorers Coordinator will review duties and procedures and be on-site for questions or issues.

Work Environment: This is primarily an outdoor position, some activities are under a tent. This is an active and busy environment. We look to our volunteers to maintain a safe, orderly and FUN environment so that each child participant feels welcome and special.

We provide:

- Name badge, collectible D@D pin, our annual volunteer gift, and entry for prize raffle at check in.
- Parking and gate pass for the day. Pick up at Will Call.
