2023 Contest Guidelines

Dressage at Devon invites barn groups or horse-loving clubs to enter our **Explorers' Barn Day Contests**. There are two competitions you can enter!

The **Costume and Comradery** prizes will be awarded for the best **Dancin'** attire worn by a group present at the show on October 1.

Prizes also for the best uploaded **Spirit Video** of your group's spirit and activities. Just make a recording of your barn and send it in.

Costume and Comradery day of show Entry Information:

1. **Costumer and Comradery Participants** must register their barn on the Dressage at Devon website registration page by **Wednesday, September 20**. Follow the directions on the form. All entries must included the barn name and number of participants, email, barn address, etc.
2. One registration for day of show participation per barn, club or group.
3. Groups wanting to participant will purchase tickets through the Dressage at Devon [ticket site](#).
4. Each barn should have a sign indicating the barn name as registered, which they can bring with them. We will have some poster boards and markers available if needed.
5. No noise making items can be brought on to the showgrounds.
6. On the day of the show after entering the showgrounds, the **Costume and Comradery** participants should go to the Explorers' Tent for check-in.
7. Winners will be announced and prizes awarded at the showgrounds after the Centerline Ride on Sunday, October 1.

Spirit Video Entry Information:

1. **Spirit Video entries** must submit their video/group on the Dressage at Devon website registration page by **Friday, September 15**. Follow the directions on the form. All entries must included the barn name and number of participants, email, barn address, etc.
2. Videos should be emailed by **Friday, September 15**, to: dressage.explorers@dressageatdevon.org
3. Videos will be judged prior to Grand Prix night and the winning group will be notified by Wednesday, September 20. Tickets can be picked up at the will-call office. A maximum of 10 tickets and swag bags will be awarded.
4. Videos should be in your cell phone format.
5. Entries will be judged on originality, design, artwork, adherence to theme and message. Artistic merit is important.
6. Video must be in English.
7. Video can be between one (1) and two (2) minutes in length. Videos longer than two (2) minutes will not be accepted.
8. Video must be original work and not previously published.
9. Video submissions must **not** contain any elements of music, audio, speech/voiceover or other audiovisual material that is protected by someone else's copyright or trade secret or otherwise subject to third party rights. Video submissions must include music credit. (suggested websites: audiojungle.com, soundcloud.com, newground.com)
1. Privacy—Finalist and winners may be publicly identified by name and town.
2. Video submissions must adhere to the norms of civil discourse and must be suitable for viewing by individuals of any age and not contain profanity.
3. All participants in the Dressage at Devon Explorers' Barn Day contest give the rights to the Dressage at Devon Horse Show to use, without limitation, the video on its website, in promotional materials, or for any other marketing needs.
