Volunteer Job Description

Pub Crew - Server and Helper

Overview: The Pub is a fan favorite and wonderful partnership that brings much needed funds to both the show, and our partner organization, Delaware Valley Combined Training Association. Most Pub Volunteers are family/friends/members of DVCTA, but enthusiastic, responsible, and customer-oriented volunteers are welcome. Great spot for anyone new to Dressage at Devon!

What will I do?

Ensure only patrons 21 and older are served alcohol. You may also take customer orders, pour/serve beer and wine, run the cash register, maintain stock, bus tables, and keep area clean.

Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 - must be 21 to pour/serve.
- Reliable
- Friendly and professional demeanor.

Training:

- On the job training provided just prior to start of first shift by Pub Manager or another volunteer. Will include overview of operations, cash register, serving procedures, location of stock, etc. as needed.

Work Environment: This a covered pavilion with no air conditioning or heating so dress appropriately. While there may be some slow times, the crowd can get lively and large. We encourage a fun and safe environment for our customers and volunteers.

Location: Report to Pub Area in the Picnic Grove area

Time Commitment: 3-hour shift minimum, Pub hours vary during Show Week:
11am - 8pm Tues-Th, 11am - 11pm Fri-Sat, and 11-5 Sunday
-Report to Pub at least 20 minutes before scheduled start time.
