Volunteer Job Description

Scribe - Performance Division

Overview: Performance Division Scribes are specialized volunteers with significant experience in assisting judges at rated shows and at FEI levels. We use a dedicated software program, BlackHorse1, for all Performance classes and prefer scribe volunteers with recent experience with that program. Scribes are matched with a judge for as many days possible. Scribes must work at least half days, with full days strongly preferred. Must understand that schedule may be altered as a result of a judge's preference.

What will I do?

- Check in to Volunteer Room before every shift to ensure current info/assignment.
- Pick up/Return Judge's Booth basket at the Volunteer Room as needed.
- Review Day schedule to ensure the correct tests are available.
- Report to assigned judges booth at least 10 minutes before scheduled start time.
- Record all judge's remarks and scores accurately and quickly using provided tablet.
- Review any feedback/concerns from judge to ensure best possible teamwork.

Requirements:

- Must have scribed for at least 3 Regional Championships or CDI's in last 2 years. New scribes must provide show management contacts as a reference.
- Minimum of two half days - preference given to those available for whole and/or multiple days.
- Complete any required training. Upon completion of training, demonstrate proficiency on the BlackHorse1 scribing software and Degree of Difficulty add on if required for Freestyle classes.
- Flexible and professional demeanor - schedule change is possible at request of judge.
- Good keyboard skills including use of tablet keyboard, mouse and touch screen.
- Min age: 18
- May not have a conflict of interest.
- Neat and professional appearance - no jeans.

Training:

- On-line training to be offered prior to the show week.
- Hands on training/refresher before start of shifts.

Work Environment: This is an outdoor position under cover of judge's booth and subject to weather conditions. Be prepared to work in a wide range of possible conditions. Works with national/international judges as assigned. Scribes must sit for prolonged periods and maintain focus in a highly charged environment with only scheduled breaks.

Tablet w/ loaded software

Shield for glare

Judges Booth basket from Volunteer Office OR Secretary's Office - with day sheets.

Department: Competition Support/Scribe Coordinator

Location: Report to Volunteer Room under East 3 Grandstand

Time Commitment: Up to 10-hour shift, dependent on length of competition day.
